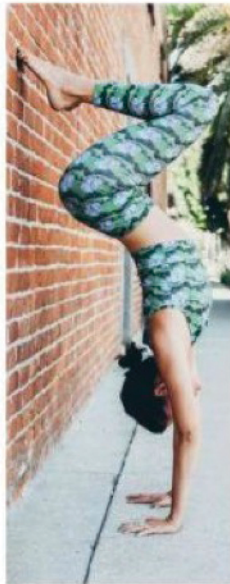


## Lhotse yoga clothing
